	Does it represent current early childhood “recommended practice”?			
	Does it have a clear purpose?			
	Has the resource been recently updated?			
	Video: Is it appropriate for the target audience?

	Does it address current policy issues or avoid contradicting current policy?			
	Are sources cited?			
	Does it offer an easily accessible way to search for information within the site (i.e. search box)?

	Does it contain culturally appropriate language (e.g, respects the diversity of the Illinois population and uses current “person first” language)?
